Euro-Quest STUDENT COMPETITION 2020

Entry Criteria

Entrants must fulfil the minimum requirements below:

- a. Be a member of a class group in a school to which a Euro-Quest Leader (supervising Teacher or Guidance Counsellor) has been assigned
- b. Have successfully enrolled as a STUDENT on www.euro-quest.ie
- c. **On or before the 30th of April 2020** have completed the Euro-Quest resource (course) in its entirety and downloaded the accompanying STUDENT Certificate

Selection Process

- In May 2020 NCGE/Euroguidance Ireland will export a list of all schools who have **at least one student** who completed Euro-Quest in the given period **and** downloaded the accompanying STUDENT Certificate
- In May 2020 NCGE/Euroguidance Ireland will (through random draw) select 3 x schools from this total list
- In May 2020 NCGE/Euroguidance Ireland will advise the LEADER in each of the 3 schools initially drawn do a further class / group draw to determine the individual winner in their school. *The mechanics of this draw will be at the discretion of individual schools / teaching staff.*

Terms and Conditions

- Prizes consist of 3 x iPad 32GB with Wi-Fi
- One prize is allocated to each of the 3 winning (drawn) schools
Only one student per each winning school can be nominated as winner
- Any prize awarded cannot be exchanged for monetary value or any other item
